## Message from the chair - Stewart Rowney

This year has been one of **growth and impact**. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, volunteers, and partners, we have been able to make a meaningful change and are proud of the difference we continue to make in the lives of children and young people in the community.

**2025** will be the **100**<sup>th</sup> year of the Charity, which began as a children's holiday and convalescent home at Brig-y-Don House in St Clement, Jersey. Today, rebranded in 2018, Brightly is a dedicated charity still focussing on improving the lives of children and young people across Jersey.

While much has changed over the past century, our fundamental purpose remains unchanged: to support children and young people who are supported by Children's Services and those facing adversity. Our support makes a real difference to the life experiences and opportunities of vulnerable children and young people in Jersey. There are also less obvious but equally important benefits that result from our work, such as greater social inclusion, financial independence, personal growth and development and social mobility, particularly for care-experienced young people

### Highlights of 2023/2024

- £204,464 awarded in funding
- Over 400 children benefited from our support
- **34 Care-experienced young people** accessed their IMOG (Independent Moving on Gift) to purchase household items, helping them set up their first home and begin their journey towards independence.
- **75 children and their families** received financial support towards medical and dental costs, family memberships and activities and **65 received** a gift for Christmas.
- **21 Looked after children** received financial support for memberships, laptops, activities, holidays and trips.
- **28 Birthday vouchers** were provided to celebrate care experienced young people's 18<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> birthdays. **19 living in residential care** received Christmas gifts.
